



UFLPA Compliance Declaration

On 23 December 2021, President of the United States – Mr. Joe Biden signed into law the Uyghur Forced Labour Prevention Act of 2021 (The “Uyghur Act” or “UFLPA”).

The Uyghur Act, effective from 21 June 2022, will strengthen the prohibition on U.S. imports of goods made through forced labor by focusing on goods mined, produced, or manufactured, in whole or in part, in the Xinjiang Uyghur Autonomous Region in China (“Xinjiang”).

The products manufactured by Fisk Alloy, Inc. do not contain any material mined, manufactured or produced from China’s Xinjiang Uyghur Autonomous Region.
