



Proposition 65 Declaration

Certain products supplied by Fisk Alloy, Inc. contain Nickel, a chemical listed on California's Safe Drinking Water & Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986. This Act, commonly known as Proposition 65 (Prop 65), establishes a list of chemicals that the state of California has determined present a risk of cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm.

The products that fall under this Act include Nickel-plated copper alloy wire and conductors, Grade A Nickel conductors, and Nickel containing alloys, manufactured to customer requirements.
